

Political Thriller Poses Ingenious Solution to America's Woes

New York, NY, November 18, 2014 - In the aftermath of Republicans wresting control of the Congress from Democrats by picking up eight senate seats—possibly nine with Louisiana poised for a December 6 runoff—a spark has been lit with voters across the nation. In a Washington, DC press conference amidst a crowd shouting, "USA! USA!" Senate Campaign Chair Jerry Moran of Kansas said of the Republican victory, "It means great things for the United States Senate, and it means great things for the United States of America."

Nearing the end of what many consider two terms of miserably failed policies, politics, and promises, Americans are clamoring for freedom from the current regime with a passion akin to calls for a second American Revolution. Despite hope engendered by a shift in the balance of Congressional power, the outcome at the polls is not necessarily an endorsement of Republicans. More likely, it reveals the extent to which voters disapprove of the Obama Administration across the board. The results are particularly telling in light of an October speech wherein President Obama stated that the midterm elections would be a referendum on his policies. "I'm not on the ballot this fall...but make no mistake, these policies are on the ballot. Every single one of them," he said. In his debut novel, *The Revolutionists*, author Biff Price weaves an intricate tale of American politics run amok that mirrors the headlines, and offers a provocative and darkly comical solution to the social and economic woes brought on by Progressive ideology. Complete with power-mad politicians, terrorists, and American heroes, the plot centers around an evil conspiracy to take over the United States and a shocking plan to save it.

Be warned, the book's characterizations of Progressives will be jarring to readers more accustomed to hearing Republicans and conservatives described as elitist career politicians and worse. Price draws a clear line from Progressive viewpoints to policies that many would say have caused a steady downward spiral in the United States' status in the world, and even in the minds of her citizens. In the end, the book proposes a solution to the country's problems that is at once entertaining and thought provoking...and not as impossibly far fetched as one might have believed before the midterm elections.





Biff Price has worn many hats as a college professor, English teacher, disc jockey, talk show host, newspaper columnist, editor, creative director, and fiction writer. He has also worked in construction, manhandled drums of antifreeze and motor oil, and understands the value of hard, backbreaking work. He is a writer who knows what it is like to get up early in the morning, put in a full day, and go to bed tired, just like millions of Americans do every day.

The Revolutionists is his first venture into topical fiction, and he wrote it with one idea in mind: Create a fun read peppered with truly outrageous characters, some of whom come to a very bad end—being eaten by a lion qualifies as very bad, and others who go on to live another day in upcoming sequels.

In his career, Biff Price has written for radio and TV, newspapers, magazines and the Internet. He's also led writer's groups and taught English and writing in a foreign land via SKYPE. A former faculty member at Rowan University, he taught writing skills to graduate students for over fifteen years, and wrote editorial content for several magazines. An avid reader of good fiction, he was inspired to write fiction of his own, including The Revolutionists trilogy. He's also penned a series of children's books, the first of which is slated for release next year.

Price teaches English and writing to international students, some of whom are creating fictional stories as part of their learning. He emphasizes using one's imagination to create stories with depth, and he challenges students to explore and write about scenarios they'd never considered. The approach is freeing and of real benefit to students who are trying their hand at fiction writing for the first time.

He is active in writers' groups, and he enjoys working with writers who have been published, as well as those who are just beginning. He's quick to point observe that the world of publishing is changing dramatically every day. Smart phones, tablets, and the ever-evolving landscape of electronic devices are eclipsing traditional ways of getting information, but Price believes the good news is that there are still millions of people who also like to read physical books.


His stated objective as a writer is to entertain the reader. "Someone else can write the Great American novel! It's hard enough to write good fiction," he quips.


